

## **Important Information to make YOUR Labor Day Picnic Great:**

- Check-in with your Local to get food and drink tickets. Membership cards will be available to sign if you aren't a member. The colors for each local are listed on the front.
- Tables will be set up for AFSCME committees. You may want to stop by to talk with each group about their programs and work.
- Food will be served between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. After 2 p.m. we cannot guarantee how much food will be available
- Each Local has their own program regarding offering ride bracelets. Ride lines can be very long. Extra all day ride bracelets (\$9.75) can be purchased from Oaks Park and cover all rides except the Go Karts. Roller skating is included with a ride bracelet; only GoKarts are excluded.
- Parking at Oaks Park is very limited. Oaks Parks runs two shuttles through the neighborhood to the front gate.
